

Poetica Musica at Old Westbury Gardens

On Saturday, Oct. 15 at 8 p.m., Poetica Musica at Old Westbury Gardens will feature "Masters of Modern Spain." The event will take place in the Red Ballroom.

With special support from the Consulate General of Spain in New York and the Manhattan School of Music, Old Westbury Gardens is hosting this special evening featuring works by Da Falla, Rodrigo, Turina, and other composers.

Special guests artists, Jesus Reina, violin, and Jessica Bowers, mezzo-soprano, will join Poetica Musica

Poetica Musica is a consortium of eight musicians who are currently Artists-in-Residence at Westbury House, a stately mansion on the grounds of Old Westbury Gardens located on Long Island's North Shore. Individually and collectively, members have performed in such music festivals as Tanglewood, Ravinia, Aspen, Jerusalem and Edinburgh and with the Metropolitan, New York City Opera, Minnesota, Chicago and Houston Opera Companies. Members of Poetica Musica have performed at St-Martin-in-the-Fields in London, the Holywell Music Room in Oxford, Carnegie and Alice Tully Halls in New York and at the Library of Congress in Washington, D.C. They have toured in over 40 countries including: Turkey, India, Bosnia, Serbia, Denmark, Norway, Azerbaijan, and Poland, and Kuwait.

Tickets are \$20.00 members, students, and seniors, and \$25 non-members. There is a guided tour of the house or gardens at 6:45 p.m., followed by a pre-concert talk at 7:30 p.m. Following the 8 p.m. performance in the Red Ballroom, there will be a wine/dessert reception on the West Porch.
